This is the sixth Wally developed in the line of the successful 24 meters (80 footers) like Genie of the Lamp, Magic Carpet and Askherout. She shares similar hull and deck lines and reflects the overall concept of simplicity carried throughout the project. While she is unique in the interior layout: the owner's stateroom is on the port side and the two guest cabins fitted with twin bunks are forward and share the shower.
